The World of Baseball Gathers in Gijang

The 29th Gijang World Youth Baseball Championship (under 18s) will be held from August 30 for 10 days at the Gijang-Hyundai Motors Dream Ballpark (1-ro 155, Ilgwangmyeon Sports Park). A total of 12 countries, divided into two teams, will participate. South Korea, ranked third in the world, is in Group A with Australia (7th), The Netherlands (8th), Canada (10th), Nicaragua (15th) and China (20th). Japan, the United States, Taiwan, Panama, South Africa and Spain were placed in Group B.

Preliminary matches will be held from the opening ceremony taking place on the afternoon of August 30 up to September 3, while the super round matches will be held from

September 5 to 7, and the finals will take place along with the closing ceremony on the evening of September 8.

In July, Gijang completed safety checks and maintenance of the stadium and major tourist attractions, and also recruited volunteers for the event. KTX and the Government Buildings Management Office are posting advertisements in various places to help create an air of anticipation.

Art Museum: Escape from the heat at the science museum



Busan National Science Museum is operating a 'Water Playground' for the summer vacation. It has pools 30cm in depth and various water facilities such as a mushroom fountain and a rainbow tunnel. It is open from 11 am to 4:30 pm until August 18. In addition, the summer semester education program includes a child science classroom, an experiment classroom, a parents' classroom, a software coding classroom, and a creative maker classroom. Students will receive free admission tickets to permanent exhibition halls and the astronomical observation hall.

The Children's Museum at the Busan Museum of Art hosts the Thing Think exhibition 'The Skill of Relationships' by Jemma Han during the summer vacation. This exhibition is based on the theme of 'relationships' which the artist has been interested in for a long time. It stimulates the imagination of children by combining materials from daily life and cooking activities such as nails, zippers and plugs. During the exhibition period, the artist will explain pictures and give performances, while education programs enabling children and families to draw pictures together will be available. The exhibition runs until August 25 and is free admission.



Successful company space allocation for the Southeast area industrial complex

Five companies, Futurechem Co. Ltd., Hojin Industrial Co. Ltd., New Korea Industrial Co., Ltd., ITTSAN GTLS and Bando Gijeon, have received priority allocation for the Southeast area radioactive medicine industrial complex. The five companies which have decided to move into the industrial complex are small giant enterprises, which are recognized as being technologically advanced in the global market by manufacturing medical and industrial radiation devices using radioisotope.

The Southeast area radiation medicine complex, which is being built by Gijang, is expected to be the world's center for radiation technology to cover 1.48 million square meters and totals 429.8 billion won in project costs. It is planned for completion on December 31, 2020, and is expected to induce the production effect of 2.11 trillion won and employment of more than 21,000 people.



Imrang Summer Music Festival: The music of youth and romance

The Imrang Summer Music Festival will be held on the 17th to 18th on Imrang Beach, with its beautiful pine forest and secluded scenery. The event will consist of a national Children's Song Contest, Seaside College Song Festival, and celebration performances by popular singers.

The Children's Song Contest will be held on the 17th, and elementary school students from all over the country will compete in solo and chorus song contests. On the 18th, the Seaside College Song Festival will showcase a powerful stage with eight teams of college students.

The sands of Imrang Beach are over 1km wide and old pine trees are dotted around the white sandy beaches like unfolding screens. There are many raw fish restaurants, cafes, and accommodation in the beach area. Compared to other beaches in Busan, you can enjoy the sea quietly.
