





## Installation of two-way walk-through booth at Gijang Health Center

The Gijang Health Center installed an interactive walk-through booth for screening on the 21st of April, which is effective for COVID 19 examinations for overseas arrivals. With the existing sound pressure tent-type screening clinic, medical staff and examiners wearing protective clothing entered a tent to collect samples, but this bidirectional walk-through booth can control sound pressure and positive pressure through simple filter replacement. In addition, medical personnel can safely collect samples in the booth without wearing protective clothing. The walk-through booth is ready for the next examination after 5 minutes of natural ventilation.

## We can help you 'jipkok' (stay at home) in a fun and satisfying way at home

The social distancing caused by the spread of COVID 19 means a limit to outdoor activities and more time staying in, which means people can become lethargic and feel tired of routine. Here are some tips to have fun at home:

### Gijang Library (Gijang Library, Jeongwan Library)

We are implementing a safe book loan service. If you select the desired book and pick up time on the library website, you can pick up the requested book the next morning (10am-12pm) and afternoon (15-17pm) at a time you want. You can borrow up to 3 books once a week. There is also a loan service for the book you want to read, where you can borrow a book from a nearby bookstore and return it to the library after reading it.

### Gijang Child Care Center

The center is operating a drive-through toy rental service. Visit the center's website, search for rental toys, and apply by phone. The toys can be picked up from Tuesday to Saturday at the special rental booth in the center parking lot. The rental period is two weeks for toys and four weeks for child care products. Parents and children can participate in live broadcasts of Zumba, kids' yoga and cooking programs.

### Busan National Science Museum

The museum is running an online science experiment education program through a YouTube channel. It introduces various experiences such as making cheese, cooking scrambled eggs, making musical instruments with recycled items and floating tomatoes on salt.

### Jeongwan Museum:

#### A museum which can be enjoyed online

The museum offers special exhibitions, fairy tales, and such as video services. As the running time is around 5 minutes long, children can watch without getting bored. You can also download learning materials related to house-shaped and bird-shaped earthenware, which are representative artifacts of the museum.



### Busan Museum

## Alcohol made from seaweed and sea kelp

The Gijang Seaweed Breeding Convergence Research Center started developing traditional seaweed liquor using seaweed and kelp. The research center will manufacture traditional liquor from seaweed and kelp, rice, and glutinous rice produced by local farmers and fishers. The center plans to create 30 liters of traditional liquor twice in spring and autumn, and after listening to opinions and feedback through tasting sessions plans to develop the tastiest traditional liquor.
